Some of the ideas that have been brought up specifically for our Youth!


- 1. Horseman's Park is offering us the Sunday's after our Saturday Shows for Youth activities. It would only cost us \$50 to rent the arena for Youth only activities.
  - Youth Only Horse Show Short Day made up of Halter, SMS, English, Western, Trail.
    - 1. Offer "Walk ONLY" classes for the younger riders to try to build confidence in the arena without the pressure of Saturdays show.
  - b) Youth Playdays Barrels, Poles, Keyhole, Egg Spoon Race, etc?
  - c) Youth Clinic Pick event, for example, pick Trail: We could have several volunteers help work different parts of the trail course. Maybe Jessica works on the Gate, or I could help work kids over the bridge, etc?
- 2. Summer Clinics at different barns in town.
  - a) One Weekend, a barn could host us and we haul our horses in to work on equitation for example, the next month another barn hosts us and we work on

reining. This gives the Youth an opportunity to expose their horses to different events and locations/arena.


- 3. Youth Judging
  - b) Ever wondered what the judge is looking for? We could do some gatherings inside, learning scoring systems, confirmation basics, horse facts, etc.
  - c) Then we could move it into a real-life judging scenario. These classes would be judged by the Youth and compared to an actual Judge's score card.
  - d) This is something that is very common for 4-H Youth to participate in. It helps build a better understanding for what is expected of them when they are out their showing. Again, it builds confidence and public speaking skills when they are able to articulate why they placed a class a certain way.
- Election of Youth Director. Every year the Youth Director is voted on by the paid Youth members. The Youth
  Director is a Volunteer senior member in good standing. Youth Director duties include: promoting youth
  activities (both at the shows and outside), organizing meetings, helping document the interests and levels of
  youth riders within the club, and tracking incentive programs (or whatever program we decide to pursue going
  forward).
